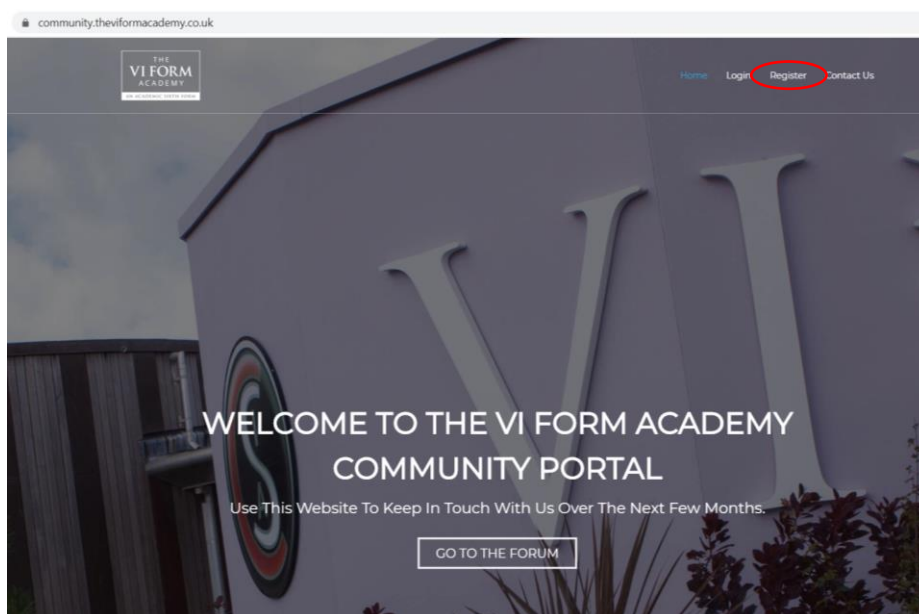


The VI Form Academy Community Portal – Student Guide

Visit <https://community.theviformacademy.co.uk>. Click Register in the top right corner



Enter a username and your first and last names. Please ensure that you use your full real name so we can match you to your application. You need to enter a valid email address – not your school one. Click “Register” when done.

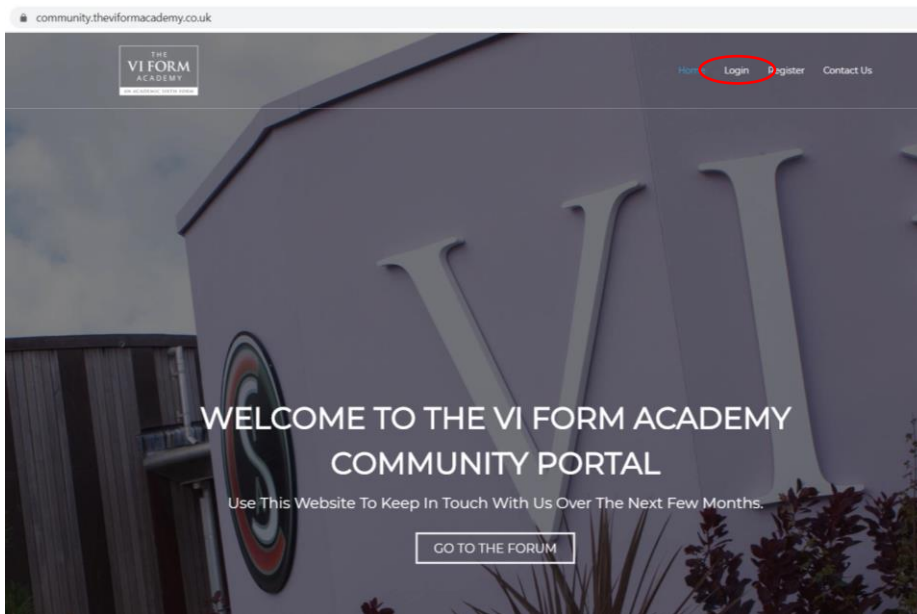

Type in your username and password, then click “Login”.

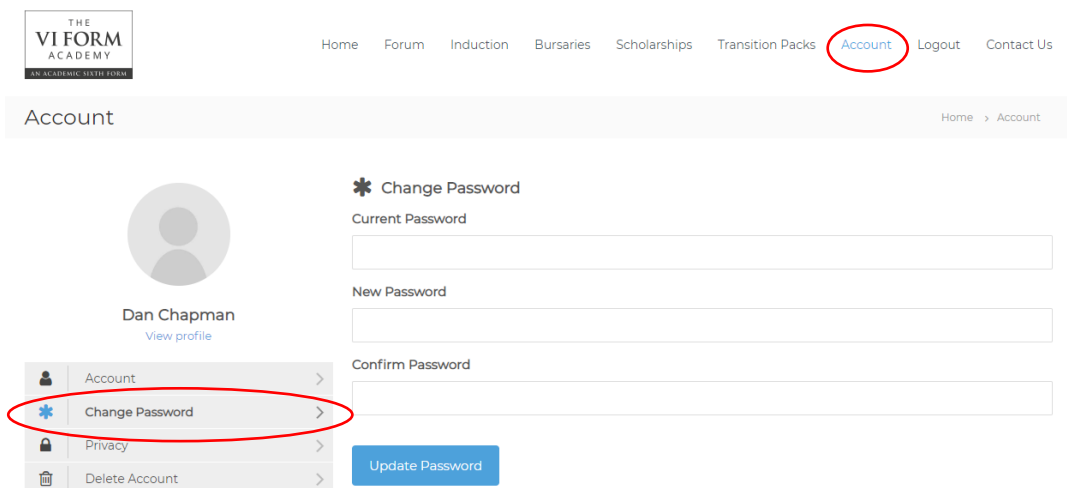

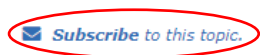
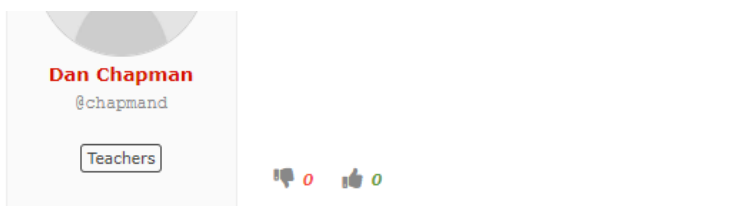

Bursaries

The Bursaries section of the website contains useful information about the discretionary and transport bursaries available at the VI Form Academy.

The forms to apply for these will become available on the 30th June.



VI Form Academy students can apply for bursary support to help with education-related costs. Further information on the 16-19 bursary fund can be found on the government website: <https://www.gov.uk/1619-bursary-fund>

Although there are limited funds available, the VI Form Academy are committed to ensuring that we offer some financial support to those students who have genuine financial difficulties that might otherwise prevent them continuing in education.

Discretionary Bursary

Our discretionary bursary is a means tested cash payment for use by students in supporting their education to purchase items such as clothing, books and equipment. To apply, we will need details of your household's financial circumstances and evidence to support your claim – information provided will be strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose of awarding discretionary bursaries. Students applying for a bursary must all be assessed and support is awarded based on actual financial need.

If successful, the payments will be made directly into the student's own bank account at two intervals throughout the year. The value available to individual students will depend on the number of applicants and will be advised to students in October. Receipt of a bursary is conditional on meeting agreed standards set by CSIA and payment can be withheld if the conditions of the award are not met. These conditions are detailed in The VI Form Student Contract which requires the student and parent/carer signature before payments are released.

Scholarships

The VI Form Academy is very proud to be able to provide students with opportunities beyond the traditional classroom. Students are encouraged to enrich themselves in anticipation of securing a place at university, an apprenticeship, or employment.

The VI Form Academy recognises the value of independence in raising aspirations and outcomes for students and has a limited number of Scholarships available to support students with ambitious enrichment and academic plans. Students can apply for financial support to allow an exceptional challenge to take place.

The VI Form Academy is dedicated to supporting students to become independent and arranges a variety of opportunities to support this aim. Over the past five years, VI Formers have used the VI Form Scholarship to participate in international conservation and aid in Ghana and Argentina; join residential exam preparation courses to Villiers Park; experience uni life in Oxford; learn to drive, scuba dive, fly, parachute, teach snowboarding, and get work experience in Morocco, Tanzania, Canada, Spain and Dominican Republic.

There are limited awards available so the expectation is that applications will need to be to a very high standard.

Transition Packs

Studying A Levels requires an excellent foundation knowledge of GCSE content as well as a commitment to independent study.
